



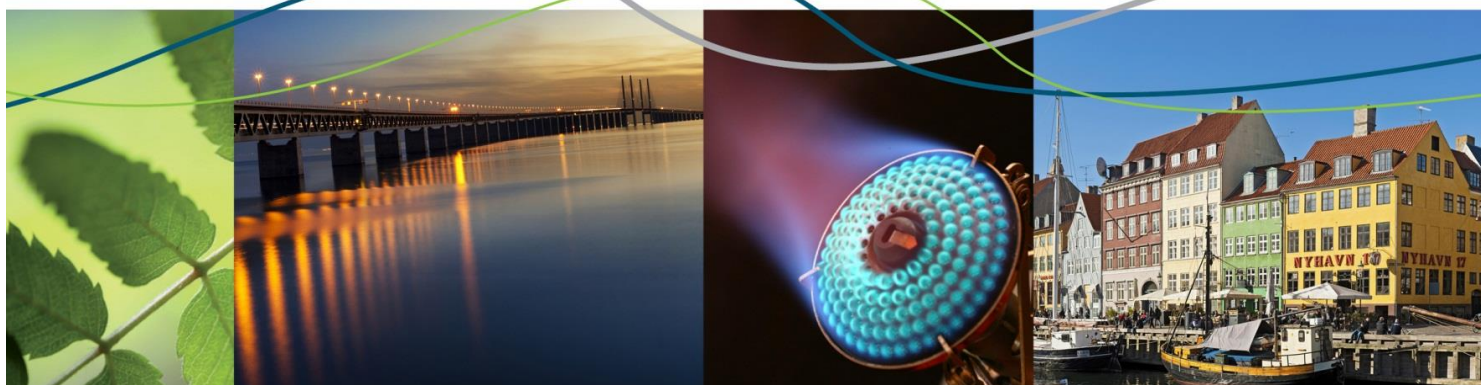

## IGRC2014 in Copenhagen, Denmark 17-19 September 2014

The conference is organised by Danish Gas Technology Centre (DGC) acting on behalf of the Danish Gas Association, the IGU charter member from Denmark.

Peter I. Hinstrup, Honorary Member of IGU is appointed IGRC2014 Conference Director.

The conference is governed by the IGU Executive Committee (IGU EXC) under the chairmanship of the IGU President.

The conference technical programme is developed by the IGU Programme Committee F for Research, Development and Innovation (IGU PGC F) under the chairmanship of Jack Lewnard, Chesapeake Utility, USA.
